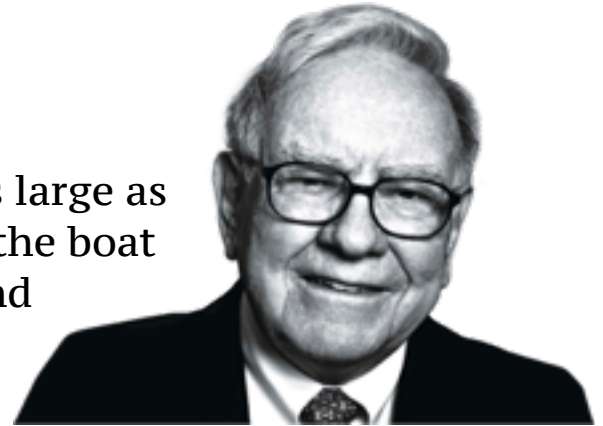

“Basically, you just want a sail that is as large as possible. The bigger the sail, the faster the boat will go because it will transfer more wind energy to overcome inertia and create momentum.”

“Small sails are better because they have less air resistance; think about a car: you wouldn't want it to be shaped like a big sail! That's the same reason you want your boat and your sail to be long and skinny - so it cuts through the water like a knife.”
