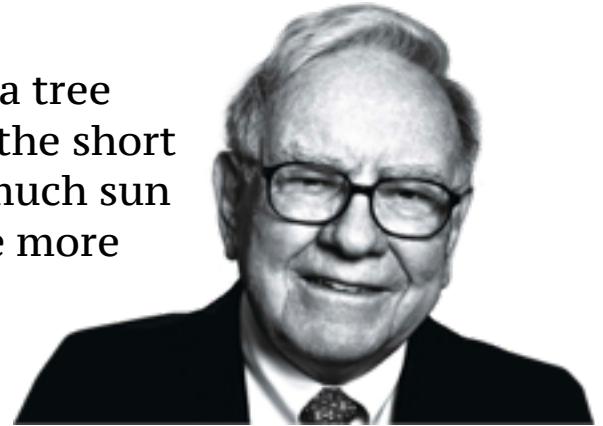

“Natural selection is simple. If you had a tree that was short, and a tree that was tall, the short tree would die because it didn’t get as much sun and the tall tree would live and produce more seeds. And every single one of those seeds would turn into a tall tree! And that’s how natural selection works.”



“You are forgetting something Warren. Trees reproduce genetically, so let’s say you have a tall tree and a short tree. Their genes, or DNA, combine, and you get an in between height tree.”



“You two are both forgetting time. Natural selection takes time to create big differences between species. For example, it probably took 2, maybe even 3 generations for a big change like donosaurs evolving into birds.”
